| Date | Topics/ Skills covered |
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| 7 July 2025 | You will begin with an introduction to the process of making, trimming, drying, firing and glazing pots. There will be a practical demonstration of wedging, centering and opening a pieces of clay on the wheel, then you will learn how to pull up the walls to form a straight pot/cylinder. After this demonstration you will begin to practice these foundational stages. |
| 8 July 2025 | Your lesson will begin with a demonstration for wedging and making bowls. You will then begin to focus on centering and opening before stretching curved walls, creating soup and cereals style bowls. |
| 9 July 2025 | Having learnt the basics of making cylinders and bowls, you will now have time to practice these forms and to experiment making some new creations that are a little larger. In the afternoon you will experiment with different curved shapes, attempting small vases or bottle forms. This is a day will focus on experimentation and help you improve upon the techniques you have developed in the first two sessions. |
| 10 July 2025 | In this session you will neaten the pieces you've made by trimming away excess clay. This will then reveal the final shape of your pots. After this is complete, you will also have to opportunity to add handles to you pieces. |
| 11 July 2025 | On the final day of your course you will apply colour and pattern to your finished pieces using coloured slips. Your tutor will guide you on how to create a mini collection by harmonising your work with a common motif, or experimenting on each piece individually. |
