## DAILY BREAKDOWN

Date	Topics/ Skills covered
1 November 2025	You will learn how to print using repurposed Tetrapak, which is widely used to make cartons for fruit juices, fresh soups, etc. The tutor will guide you in exploring the nature of this versatile material which can be torn, cut, crumpled, peeled and inscribed with drawn marks to print exciting images. In the morning you will experiment with mark making, inking and printing with Tetrapak, using a traditional etching press. In the afternoon you will make a small edition of colourful prints using the techniques learned.
2 November 2025	In the morning you will experiment with combining Tetrapak with other scrap materials, such as bubble wrap, kitchen foil, tissue paper and fragments of cloth. In the afternoon, you will be able to choose a selection of techniques and materials to make a small experimental set of prints.
