26 October 2025	Sunday AM Prepare your etched lino block for printing. Learn how to ink up your blocks and run them through the press, registering them correctly. We will also consider how to combine monoprinting with linoprint. Sunday PM Continue printing. You will be encouraged to experiment with different ways of inking and combining your blocks to make a varied set of prints
