Date	Topics/ Skills covered
18 April 2024	<p>Enlarging You will learn techniques for drawing accurately from photographs while playing with scale. By the end of the session you will be equipped to make a huge drawing from a tiny source image.</p> <p>You will need: a ruler, a physical copy of the image you would like to work from (you must be willing to destroy this copy), scissors</p>
25 April 2024	<p>Energy Through a number of drawing exercises we will discover how you make energetic, expressive drawings from the still, flat source material of a photograph.</p>
2 May 2024	<p>Digital manipulation to aid your drawing Sometimes you really want to make a drawing from an image but your photo isn't easy to work from. We'll look at simple digital manipulations you can make to draw out the info you need to make a great drawing.</p> <p>This session will include making colour drawings please have some coloured pencils today. No additional software should be necessary, we will be using the photos apps on your phones, you can then print them out or draw from your screen.</p>
9 May 2024	<p>Drawing on photographs We will look at artists who combine photos and drawing in their work before giving new meaning to our own photographs.</p> <p>You will need a selection of photographs to work with.</p>
16 May 2024	<p>Combining images Working from two or more photos to create your own composition.</p> <p>This is easiest to do if you can physically or digitally combine your images so physical copies, scissors and glue are recommended</p>
