DATE	TOPICS / SKILLS COVERED
25 May 2024	<p>Students will develop images on zinc plates by playing with the 'accidental' in the intaglio process, exploring unusual mark-making techniques splashing, dripping and smudging to produce fascinating and unique prints. On day one the class will go through an introduction to the materials including a series of technical demonstrations.</p> <p>Participants will work on their zinc plates, implementing the acquired techniques and further etch the plates in copper sulphate.</p>
26 May 2024	<p>Further demonstrations and students will continue to proof their plates. There will be time at the end of the day for individual discussions and refinement of the images.</p>
