Afternoon: Understanding light and shade using the charcoal and rubber we will develop a tonal drawing of simple forms learning the fundamental basics of tone. 20 August 2024	Colour The class will begin with a demonstartion by your tutor, explaining some basic rules and guidelines for mixing colour. Using Still Life objects you will then be shown how to start a painting. We will use some of the approaches from the previous day to draw out the forms as well as looking at how to lay down a ground, mix colours and apply paint. 21 August 2024	Photographs Students will bring in their own photographs, or work from images provided to make a series of drawings and paintings. We will begin the class by making some drawings and painted sketches and then use these preparitory works to develop a final painting. This is a great opportunity to play with some of the approaches and techniques we will have developed over the previous two days.	NO	All drawing and acrylic painting materials.
22 August 2024	Exterior Morning: Using the wonderful surroundings on the Art Academy's doorstep we will go sketching outdoors, focusing on buildings, people, learning perspective, spatial relationships and more gestural drawing of people in Borough Market. Afternoon: We will use the sketches from the morning as starting points for a painting/drawing/collage composed and created back in the studio.
