| 24 September 2024 | Tone: Working with a limited tonal palette, students will practice mixing and applying paint. Using a still life, students will learn how to draw out the forms and develop a basic tonal underpainting. | No |
| 1 October 2024 | Colour/ Abstraction: After a basic introduction to mixing colours, students will make an abstarct painting from a simple still life. The focus will be on developing an understanding of how colour works; looking at colour relativity, complementary colours, mixing neutral colours. | No |
| 8 October 2024 | Tone/ Portrait: Working with a limited tonal palette, students will practice mixing and applying paint. Using a photograph, students will learn how to draw out the forms of the portrait and develop a basic tonal underpainting. | No |
| 15 October 2024 | Limited Palette/ Life Painting: painting the life model using a limited palette and simple mark-making techniques. | YES |
| 22 October 2024 | Colour, Texture, Paint Application: Using a still life students will be encouraged to think about mark making and the application of paint. We will explore how these approaches can be used to give a sense of what an object both looks and feels like. An introduction to painting mediums will be given at the beginning of the class. | No |
| 29 October 2024 | Landscape: For this two week project students are asked to bring in printouts of a landscape that appeals to them. These can be personal photographs or images taken from the internet. The focus will be on developing an understanding of paint handling and achieving a sense of space and depth within your painting. | No |

| 12 November 2024 | Portraits: Looking at varied examples of portrait paintings and the use of tone, colour and mark-making to paint a convincing and exciting image. Selecting an example to copy to practice mixing flesh colours and gain confidence painting a head. | No |
