## DAILY BREAKDOWN

Date	Topics/ Skills covered
20/01/2025	Tone: Working with a limited tonal palette, students will practice mixing and applying paint. Using a still life, students will learn how to draw out the forms and develop a basic tonal underpainting.
27/01/2025	Tone/ Portrait: Working with a limited tonal palette, students will practice mixing and applying paint. Using a photograph, students will learn how to draw out the forms of the portrait and develop a basic tonal underpainting.
03/02/2025	Colour: After a basic introduction to mixing colours, students will work from a simple still life. The focus will be on developing an understanding of how colour works; looking at colour relativity, complementary colours, mixing neutral colours.
10/02/2025	Colour, Texture, Paint Application: Using a still life students will be encouraged to think about mark making and the application of paint. We will explore how these approaches can be used to give a sense of what an object both looks and feels like. An introduction to painting mediums will be given at the beginning of the class.
17/02/2025	Landscape: For this two week project students are asked to bring in printouts of a landscape that appeals to them. These can be personal photographs or images taken from the internet. The focus will be on developing an understanding of paint handling and achieving a sense of space and depth within your painting.
24/02/2025	Landscape W2: Finishing the painting from the previous week.
03/03/2025	Portraits: Looking at varied examples of portrait paintings and the use of tone, colour and mark-making to paint a convincing and exciting image. Selecting an example to copy to practice mixing flesh colours and gain confidence painting a head.
10/03/2025	Portraits W2: Completing the painting from the previous week.
17/03/2025	Self Directed: For the final two weeks of the course, students will be able to descide what they want to paint. Thinking about what has inspired or interested them from the previous weeks and what direction their paintings may take in the future.
24/03/2025	Self Directed W2: Continuing your paintings from the previous week
