## DAILY BREAKDOWN

	Topics/ Skills covered	Model?
<b>Morning</b>	Students will be introduced to watercolours and inks and their properties and encouraged to explore them through a number of guided exercises. Students will learn about colour mixing and layering paint with watercolour, as well as being introduced to the varying tonal values of ink and how this can be adjusted with the addition of water. Students will be introduced to various basic watercolour techniques and will be encouraged to experiment with how different pigments interact with one another as well as how watercolours and inks may be used successfully in conjunction with one another. <b>Afternoon</b>	During the afternoon session students will apply techniques learnt in the morning to their interpretation of a still-life, which they can construct themselves or with the support of the tutor. Students can choose to work solely in watercolour/ink or a combination of the two. Students will be guided through the process of constructing a composition and will be able to experiment with working at a larger scale should they wish. At the end of the session students will have at least one finished artwork to take home and a selection of colour and tonal studies and experimentations.	NO
