Date	Topics/ Skills covered
Monday 30th March	Introduction to Manga techniques Learning how to compose manga style faces and facial expressions. The session will look at drawing figures and examining different body types, movements, and body perspective. The day will also include a number of exercises on drawing hands and feet.
Tuesday 31st March	How to create attractive characters Day 2 will introduce you to character designs including how to draw details such as hair styles, costumes and accessories. You will also learn about basic use of paneling, speech bubbles, onomatopoeia, and background by completing a number of exercises to learn how to use them effectively.
Wednesday 1st April	Script making Using the characters you've created, you will begin composition on a given situation and creating a short script. This script will then be turned into manga page where you will also be taught how to create a Manga thumbnail
Thursday 2nd April	Final Project Continuing from the previous day you will complete your thumbnail and start inking your project by learning how to tone and adjust details with Photoshop.
