26 April 2026	<p>Tone Starting with a demonstration the afternoon will begin with an introduction to painting. We will be looking at how to apply a ground, lay out your palette and the best way to mix a simple, tonal scale.</p> <p>Using a limited pallet Students will work from a simple arrangement of white objects in order to understand light, shadow, shape and contrast.</p>	No
3 May 2026	<p>Colour Starting with an introduction to colour mixing, students will then create a painting of a still life in full colour. You will also be guided by your tutor on all aspects of colour mixing and learn some techniques on how to match the colours you are seeing.</p>	NO
10 May 2026	<p>Landscape Working from your own photographs, or images provided by your tutor, you will start a landscape painting that will be worked on over two weeks. Students will combine ideas and concepts from earlier in the course to generate a sense of space and depth within their paintings. Again we will look at matching colours and experiment with the application of paint.</p>	No
17 May 2026	Landscape Week 2 Continuing with the Landscape you started in the previous week.	No
24 May 2026	Portrait Week 1 Looking at varied examples of portrait paintings and the use of tone, colour and mark-making to paint a convincing and exciting image. Selecting an example to copy to practice mixing flesh colours and gain confidence painting a head.	No
